# JAPAN

9 DAYS





### Day 1 :Arrival Tokyo

Welcome to Japan and you will be assisted at the airport. Transfer to your hotel in the Tokyo area and you will be on your own. Overnight in Tokyo.

### Day 2 :Tokyo City Tour

Today after breakfast, you are taken for a city orientation tour where you visit the Imperial Palace (Nijubashi Bridge), Tsukiji outer Market, Stop to have Western style-Lunch, Asakusa Senso-ji Temple & Nakamise Shopping Street, Tea ceremony experience , Tokyo Tower. The rest of the day is free at leisure. Overnight in Tokyo.

### Day 3 :Tokyo – Mt. Fuji & Hakone Tour

After an early breakfast, you are taken for a day excursion with Mt. Fuji tour and Hakone Tour. Mt. Fuji 5th Station. The bus will head up to the 5th Station along the Subaru Line. The 5th Station is situated at 2,300 meters (7,546ft) above sea level. At this height, participants will be amazed at spectacular, breath-taking views from above the clouds. Lunch is not included in the tour. Proceed for Lake Ashi Cruise. This crater lake along the southwest wall of the caldera of Mt. Hakone was formed by a powerful

Volcanic eruption nearly 3,000 years ago and provides postcard views of Mt. Fuji towering 30 km northwest. Admire the superb view of Mt. Fuji from aboard a ship. Later, enjoy Mt. Komagatake Ropeway. Take a 7-minute ropeway ride to the peak of Mt. Komagatake. A total of 50 minutes will be spent here, including time to walk around at the peak. Take a cableway ride up to the spiritual Hakone Shrine Mototsumiya (Original shrine) that nestles at the mountaintop. Proceed to Hakone. Drop-off near Shinjuku Station West Exit. Overnight at hotel (Tokyo Hotel).



#### Day4: Tokyo

Today, Have Breakfast and explore the beautiful capital city on your own or have a day at leisure.

#### Day5: Bullet Train - Tokyo to Osaka

After Breakfast, head to the station to board the shinkansen bullet train from Tokyo To Shin-Osaka using your JR Pass. Overnight Stay in Osaka.

#### Day6: Excursion Tokyo & Nara Tour

After an early breakfast, you are taken for a day excursion. Board your shinkansen bullet train to Kyoto using JR Pass.

#### Nijo Castle (50 min)

A World Heritage site. Tour the historical castle completed in 1626, which was built to provide lodging for Tokugawa Shogun and as a palladium for Kyoto Imperial Palace. The impressive, elaborate carvings and decors in the Ninomaru Palace are a must-see. Nijo Castle is closed on Tuesdays in January, July, August, and December (Closed on the following day if Tuesday is a holiday.) If the castle is closed, or if the tour is during the year-end/New Years holidays, Ryoan-ji Temple will be visited instead.





#### **Kinkaku-ji Temple (45 min)**

A World Heritage site. The wooden architecture is covered in thin layers of pure gold and is surrounded by beautiful pond.

[Except Mondays] Kyoto Imperial Palace (40 min) See the Kyoto Imperial Palace, which was used as the Emperors residence until about 150 years ago. On Saturdays, Sundays, and national holidays, Kyoto Imperial Palace is closed. On these days, the tour will visit

Kitano Tenmangu Shrine instead. (Mondays, Tuesday if Monday is a national holiday, May 14-17 for the Aoi Festival, New Years holidays, and whenever there is an Imperial Household event).

#### **Kitano Tenmangu Shrine (40 min)**

On Mondays (and Tuesdays if a national holiday falls on the preceding Monday), this tour will visit Kitano Tenmangu Shrine instead of the Kyoto Imperial Palace. It is famous for housing the God of scholarship. This shrines main hall is a designated national treasure. The shrine is especially great to see during the plum blossom and

autumn leaf seasons. The tour will visit Nishi Hongan-ji Temple instead of Kitano Tenmangu Shrine on September 25 and December 25.

Overnight at hotel (Osaka Hotel)





#### **Day 7 :Excursion To Hiroshima And Miyajima Island**

Enjoy breakfast at your Hotel. Today we proceed Hiroshima And Miyajima Island. Board the Shinkansen Bullet train to Hiroshima by using the JR Pass on your own. Tour starts at Hotel Granvia Hiroshima. - Arrive at Miyajimaguchi and take the ferry to Miyajima island. Visit the famous Itsukushima Shrine and explore the surrounding area. Enjoy some local cuisine for lunch on Miyajima Island. Return to Miyajimaguchi and take the train to Hiroshima. Arrive at the Hiroshima Peace Memorial Park and Museum and spend time learning about the history of the atomic bombing of Hiroshima. Visit the Atomic Bomb Dome, a UNESCO World Heritage site, and reflect on the impact of the bombing on the city. Head back to Hiroshima Station to conclude the tour.

#### **Day 8 :Osaka**

Today, Have Breakfast and explore the beautiful capital city on your own or have a day at leisure.

#### **Day 9 : Depart from Osaka**

After wonderful journey, it's time to go back home. You have time free till you proceed to the airport on your own for your flight back home.
